Application Process for Admission

The application process for the 2014-2015 school year takes place during the month of January. Visit our website, www.tchs.net, and click the Admissions tab to apply on-line. **The deadline to apply is Friday, January 31, 2014.**

IMPORTANT

Siblings of students currently enrolled at TCH must follow these same procedures and comply with the deadlines. All sections of the on-line application must be completed and all supplemental documentation must be uploaded.

Failure to do so will result in the student's application being placed on hold, thereby delaying the admissions process, and the student will be placed in line with others in the wait pool. There is no application fee; registration fees are due at registration, following acceptance to TCH, the first week of March.

Due to the volume of applications, all deadlines will be strictly enforced.

Tuition & Fees

Tuition rates for the 2014-2015 school term are not yet available; the rates will be specified when applicants apply on-line in January. The following are the tuition and fees for the current school year (2013-2014).

Admissions Priority Point System

Points earned by each applicant is held in confidence by TCH Administration and Admissions Office.

Legacy

- Applicant will earn points for each grandparent (maternal or paternal) who is a graduate of TCH.
- Applicant will earn bonus points if he/she would be a direct third generation TCH student to enroll.

Alumni

- Applicant will earn points if one parent is a graduate of TCH, additional points if both parents are TCH graduates.

Sibling Attending TCH

- Applicant will earn points for each TCH sibling.

- Territorial—Lives within the geographical boundaries of the parish
- Registered

Grade Point Average

- Final GPA for previous school year
- Semester GPA for current school year

Complete Battery Percentile

- Points on national standardized tests taken most recently

Student Involvement

- Extra-curricular and co-curricular activities for church, school, and civic community.

Student Discipline

- Major school disciplinary infractions and/or excessive minor classroom infractions; classroom conduct grade below average (D-F)
- Few minor school disciplinary infractions; few minor classroom infractions; average classroom conduct grade (B-C)
- Never been sent to the office; no major school disciplinary infractions; classroom behavior above average (A-B)
