### 2007-2008 Tuition Reminder

The first installment payment is due by July 5<sup>th</sup> for those parents who selected the 10 month installment finance plan. If you chose the 8 month plan, your first payment is due September 5<sup>th</sup>. Avoid the \$15 late penalty. If you pay tuition in full by June 21<sup>st</sup>, you will incur no finance charge. Also, if you choose to have your tuition automatically drafted from your bank account through our direct deposit plan, the form is due to the finance office by June 18<sup>th</sup>.

For those of you who are not new to Teurlings, you know that I usually write my “read, read, read” column in the summer newsletter. It’s the column where I make the point that research has proven that the only way to really improve an ACT score is to improve reading skills and that the best way to improve reading scores is to READ. It doesn’t matter what your son or daughter reads, he or she just needs to read! We require that some reading be done over the summer, with the novels we test in English classes at the beginning of the school year (a listing of those novels as well as summer test dates was sent home with students in May and was in the May and June newsletters AND is on the TCHS website). However, if you really want your child to succeed, encourage him or her to read more than what is required. As a parent, I know it’s not easy to make a teenager see that reading is that important, but it is. The public library has an excellent list of books that appeal to teens and some of the books are accessible through the Lafayette Parish Public Library website, so teens can download the books and read them on the computer – how’s that for appealing to their “techie” nature while accomplishing a worthwhile goal?

The senior class of 2007 set a record at TCH, amassing over \$5 million in scholarship offers and TOPS awards. I think there is a challenge there for our incoming 9th-11th graders, as well as the class of 2008. All of those classes can reach the same bar and I look forward to great things academically from our students in the 2007-2008 school year.

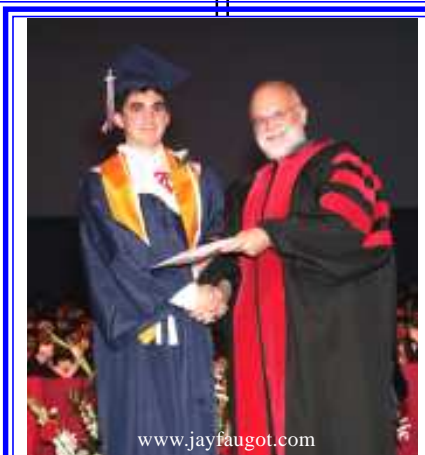
**Donna Bourgeois** was also named All State Outstanding Player.

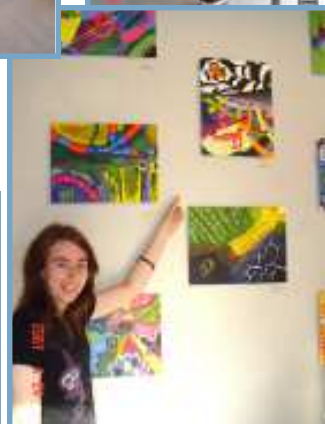

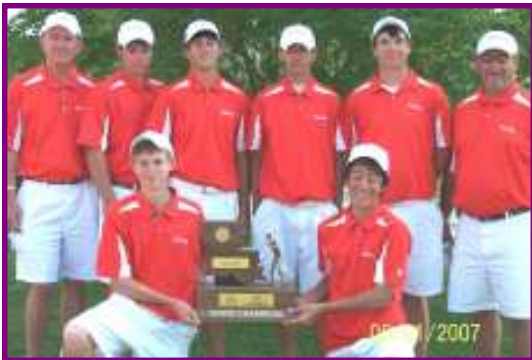
